

# Corrections for Deco Fan Pattern

## Steps for Foundation Paper B

- Place the **B1** Deco Dance fabric wrong-side down on the non-printed side of the paper, ensuring that it fully covers the B1 section on the paper with at least ¼ inch overhang over the section edges, and lightly glue or pin in place. Ensure you have the correct orientation for this fabric.
- Place the template plastic on the line between **B1 and B2**.
- Fold back the paper along the line over the template plastic
- Place the add a Quarter Ruler against the template plastic with the lip of the ruler against the plastic.
- Cut the ¼ inch seam allowance from this fabric.
- Place the **B2** Background fabric on top of the B1 piece of fabric, right sides together and lined up along the trimmed edge. Pin in place if necessary.
- Flip the foundation over to the printed side and sew on the line between **B1 and B2**
- Press **B2** piece open with the Roller Pressor or Finger Pressor.
- Give piece a final press with the iron. Trim up block on outside line.

## Border 2

Piece all the strips together end to end to make 1 long strip.

From this strip cut the following;

2 strips  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 65\frac{3}{4}$ . Sew to each side of the quilt.

**2 strips  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 77\frac{3}{4}$ .** Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
