RAINBOW TABLE RUNNER

Finished size approx. 137x 50cm

MATERIALS:

- LIBERTY - Wiltshire collection - 2½" x WOF

- 22" of BLACK fabric for border and binding

- light weight batting
- backing fabric
- DMC Perle threads

CUTTING

- CHERRY fabric
Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½"
- Sub-cut 2½" strips from the rest of the fabrics into
2½" x 4½" - 2 pieces
2½" x 6½" - 2 pieces
- BLACK fabric
Cut 3 strips 4" x WOF for border
Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF for binding

BRAIDS

Start with 2½" x 2½" square. Stitch short strip to one side. Then stitch longer strip of the same colour to the other side of the square. Press seam allowances as you go. Refer to diagram on next page and colour order on the photograph.

Keep going in this manner always starting with the short strip. From the second row as you stitch longer strip stop approx. ½" before the end of the long strip. You will finish stitching these ends while you are joining braids together.

Stitch two braids in this manner.

Position finished braid in opposite directions with longer strips facing each other. Join them together along zig zag edge one strip at the time.

RAINBOW TABLE RUNNER



Stop stitching approx. 1/2" before the end of the long strip



Trim edges straight. Stitch border pieces to the sides.

BASTING

Cut your backing to the size of table runner. With wrong sides facing, layer runner's top and backing, with batting in between. Smooth out all creases and carefully pin or baste layers together.

Quilt along the stitch lines with Running Stitch using DMC Perle cotton in variety of colours.

BINDING

We used single fold binding method to make binding less bulky for the table runner.

With right sides together, stitch three binding strips together. Press seams open.

With right sides together, sew the binding strips to the top of the table runner along the longest sides. Trim excess length.

Repeat for the shorter sides. Folding in seam allowances in the corners. Hand stitch it in place.
