# DIAMOND PLAY MAT

QUILT SIZE: approx. 26" on each side and 50" across the center

## MATERIALS:

**A** KYOTO POSEY-5907C - 0.6mtr  
Cut three strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 15 diamonds  
Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF for binding



**B** KYOTO POSEY-5907B - 0.40mtr  
Cut three strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 15 diamonds



**C** MERCHANT'S TREE-5911B - 0.3mtr  
Cut two strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 12 diamonds



**D** DAISY BAZAAR-5914B - 0.3mtr  
Cut two strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 12 diamonds



**E** JAVA FEATHER- 5912C - 0.3mtr  
Cut two strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 12 diamonds



**F** MERCHANT'S TREE-5911C - 0.15mtr  
Cut one strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 6 diamonds



**G** PAISLEY MEADOW -5913A - 0.40mtr  
Cut three strips 5" x WOF strips.  
From 5" strips cut 15 diamonds



**H** KINGLY SPRIG-5904B  
backing fabric - 2mtrs  
• batting

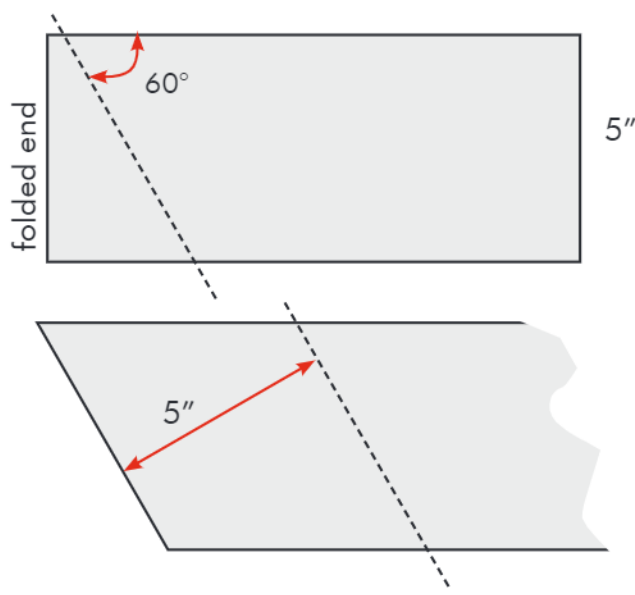


This size quilt is perfect for a play mat or large table center. To make this quilt you will need to cut 90 diamonds. The size of the quilt can be easily adjusted by adding extra rows or by changing size of the diamonds.

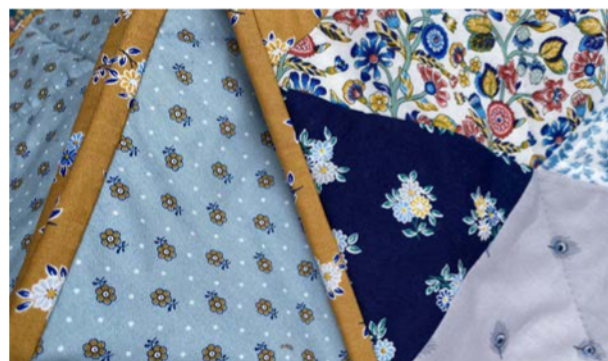
## CUTTING

Cut a 5" x WOF strips from all the fabrics.

Starting at the folded end, place the 60° line on the ruler along the length of your fabric. Trim off the fabric to the left of the ruler.



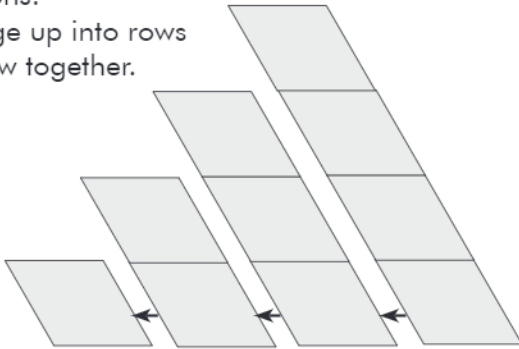
Cut 5" in width diamonds until you reach the end of the strip. You will be able to get 6 diamonds out of each 5" strip. Refer to the photo and layout diamond in the order.



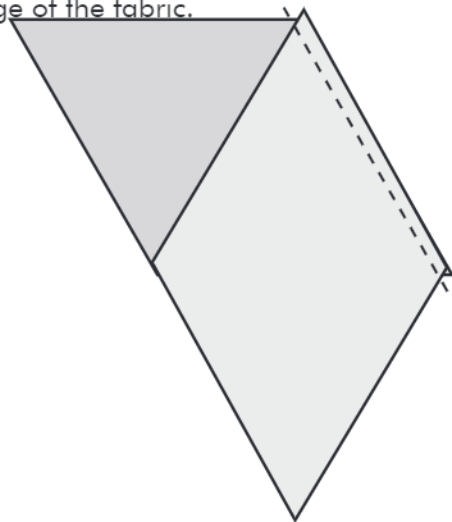


# FLOWER PLAY MAT

Separate diamonds into wedges and stitch them together in sections.  
Break each wedge up into rows and sew each row together.



To have your diamonds line up correctly, overlap the seams. The top of the diamond should be 1/4" below the edge of the fabric.



Sew three wedges together. Repeat for the other three wedges. Sew two halves together. Start pinning at the center to align center diamonds perfectly.

### BACKING

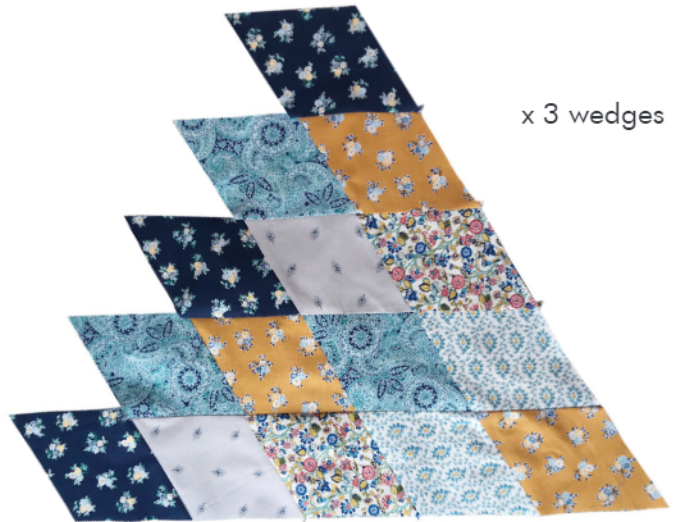
Cut the backing fabric to the length of the quilt top. Cut 3" strips to extend the width of the backing. Stitch them to the sides. Press seams open.

### QUILT ASSEMBLY

Place backing fabric on a large surface wrong side up. Place batting on top of backing fabric. Place top of the quilt on top of the batting with right side facing up. Smooth away wrinkles using your hands. Pin all layers together. Machine or hand quilt starting at the center and working towards the corners. Trim excess fabric.

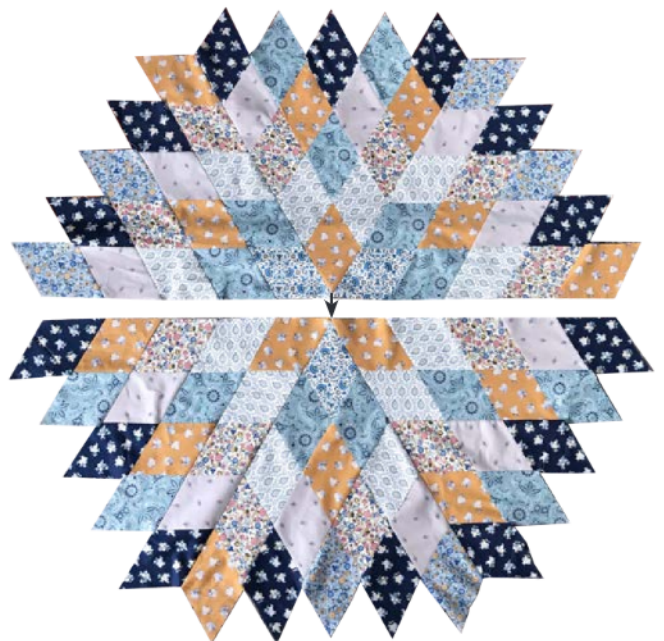
### BINDING

Join 2 1/2" binding strips together end to end using 45° seams. Open seams and press the long binding

piece in half with right sides facing out. Sew binding to the front of the quilt stopping at the points and folding it over in line with next side. Turn binding to back of the quilt and hand stitch it down.
